#### **Highlights from the May Monthly Meeting**

- Ms Shipra Sehgal, Chairman Regulatory Committee discussed the regulatory updates.
- Mr Prabhakar Mishra, Vice President discussed the concern regarding the minimum obligation for the reuse of category I (Rigid Plastic Packaging) which 10% for the year 2025-2026.
- Ms Ranjeet Kaur, General Secretary discussed the time line 1 July 2024 for the printing of name and registration certificate number for producer or importer or brand owner mentioned in the Rule 11(I) of the Plastic Waste Management Rules 2016 as amended on 30 October 2023.



#### **Highlights from the June Monthly Meeting**

- Ms Shipra Sehgal, Chairman Regulatory Committee discussed the regulatory updates further she discussed Draft notifications on Food Safety and Standards (Food Products Standards and Food Additives) Amendment Regulations, 2024) and asked members to submit their comments.
- Members in the meeting discussed how the Obligation for reuse mention in the Schedule 7.4 of Plastic Waste Management Rules 2024 as amended on 27 April 2023 have become challenging for the Brand Owners and decided to discontinue the use of rigid plastic due to the minimum obligation for the reuse of category I (Rigid Plastic Packaging) if the authority will not withdraw their obligation of reuse or give any relaxation.
- Ms Ranjeet Kaur, General Secretary discussed the manual of the food testing for confectionery and decided to submit the comment to the authorities.



- Mr prabhakar Mishra, Chairman Regulatory Committee discussed the submission of representation on the issues faced in plastic waste management rules 2016.
- Ms Shipra Sehgal, Chairman Regulatory Committee discussed regulatory updates.

## Dietary guidelines issued by Indian Council of Medical Research

The ICMR NIN- Committee has issued the Dietary Guidelines for the Indians which includes 17 Dietary Guidelines. The 17 Guidelines focuses on health promotion and disease prevention across all age groups.



# Notice for inviting stakeholders comments on the Basic Food Import Clearance Fee (BFICF)

FSSAI(Food Safety and Standard Authority of India) has issued a notice for inviting stakeholders comments. The Basic Food Import Clearance Fee is initially estimated as Rs 8400+ G.S.T per bill entry (BOE). Before Implementation of Basic Food Import Clearance Fee, Rs. 8400+ GST the comment from the stakeholders were invited before 15 July 2024.



# Provisions to FBOs to update the filed modification application of license/registration in FoSCoS.

Food Safety and Standard Authority of India (FSSAI) has issued an advisory on provision to FBOs to update the filed modification application of license/registration in FoSCoS. Earlier, Food business operators could apply for only one modification application for license/ registration at a time wherein they were required to go for the next modification of their license/ registration after the issuance of a prior modified license/ registration. Food Authority has approved the proposal to introduce an additional provision in FoSCoS allowing FBOs to cancel their Modification Application and apply for an updated modification application.

# **List of validity of FSSAI recognised Food Testing Laboratories (July)**

Food Safety and Standard Authority of India (FSSAI) has issued a list of FSSAI-recognized laboratories along with the validity of their NABL accreditation as of 12-07-2024. Contact details are enclosed herewith for the purpose of carrying out the analysis of food samples taken under the Food Safety and Standards Act, 2006, and the Rules and Regulations made there under.

FSSAI had suspended the FSSAI notified laboratories which are Mitra S.K. Private Limited, Kolkata and Cargo Inspectors & Superintendence Company Private Limited, Howrah.

# Directions to FBOs to prohibit sale/food recall in respect of Unsafe Food Samples



Food Safety and Standard Authority of India (FSSAI) has issued a direction to FBOs to prohibit sal/ food recall in respect of unsafe food samples. If the enforcement sample is opined unsafe in the primary lab report, FBOs are requested to direct the designated officer (DO's) and Central Licensing Authority (CLA's) under their respective jurisdiction to take the following action immediately:

**Prohibit the Sale of Unsafe Food** 

Recall unsafe food

The requirement of self-declaration by all the advertisers/advertising agencies is mandatory for all new advertisements released after 18 June 2024.



# Extension of the last date for filing of Annual Return for FY 2023-2024

The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEFCC) has issued a notification regarding the last date of filing an annual return on the EPR Portal for plastic packaging for the FY 2023-2024 by PIBOs & PWPs registered during the year FY 2022-2024 has been extended to 30 September 2024.



#### **Algeria Clarifies Halal Requirements:**

FAS received communication from the Algerian government clarifying that the Grand Mosque of Paris (GMP) halal certification requirement for imports to Algeria apply only to product originating from France, or from another European market where the GMP operates a halal certifying office. The clarifications on halal certification requirements were issued after reports of widespread confusion among food importers and brokers as to whether GMP certification was required for non-EU origin product. Chocolate and confectionery products would require halal certification.



### **EC Publishes the Draft Commission Regulation to Ban the Use of BPA Use in Food Contact Materials:**

This initiative will impose a ban on the use of BPA in food contact materials (FCMs), including plastic and coated packaging. This follows the publication of the European Food Safety Authority's opinion, which indicates a concern for human health.

The measure will also:

- Address the use of other bisphenols in FCMs to avoid replacing BPA with other harmful substances
- Set out derogations and transitional periods that may apply to businesses.



### Sri Lanka: New product import and certification regulation

Sri Lanka has published a new regulation on the importation of products and their certification: Imports (Standardization and Quality Control) Regulations 2024Under the Compulsory Import Inspection Scheme of Sri Lanka operated by Sri Lanka Standards Institution, importers are not permitted to import the specified items to Sri Lanka unless they conform to the relevant Sri Lanka Standards. The list of items specified under this scheme have been revised and the Gazette Extraordinary of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka No. 2384/35 dated 17 May 2024 has been published indicating a total of 161 items. The revised list includes chewing gum, bubble gum, soft candy, and hard candy under HS heading 1704.
